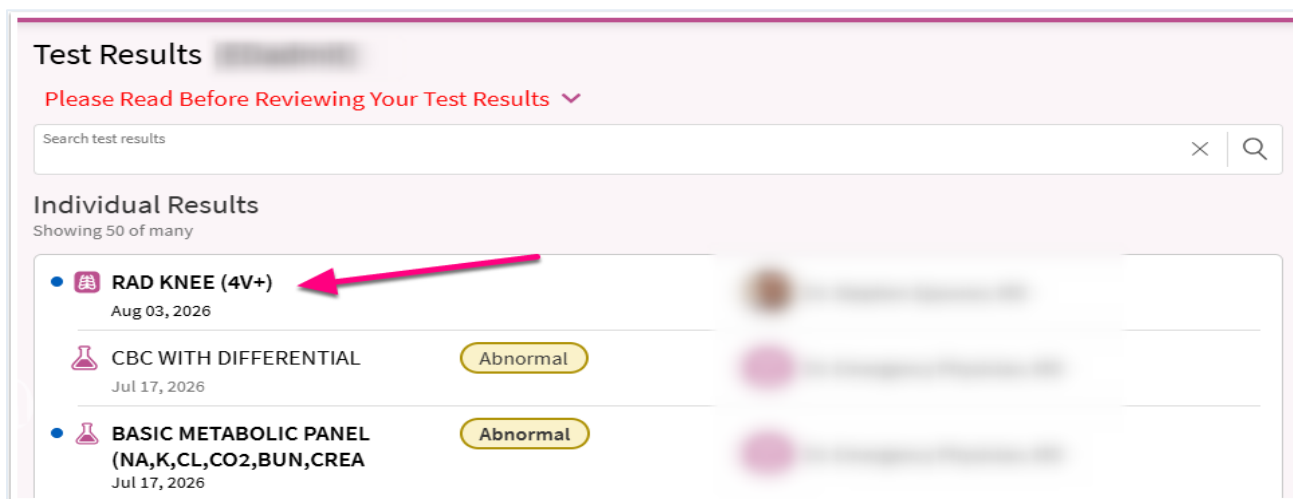
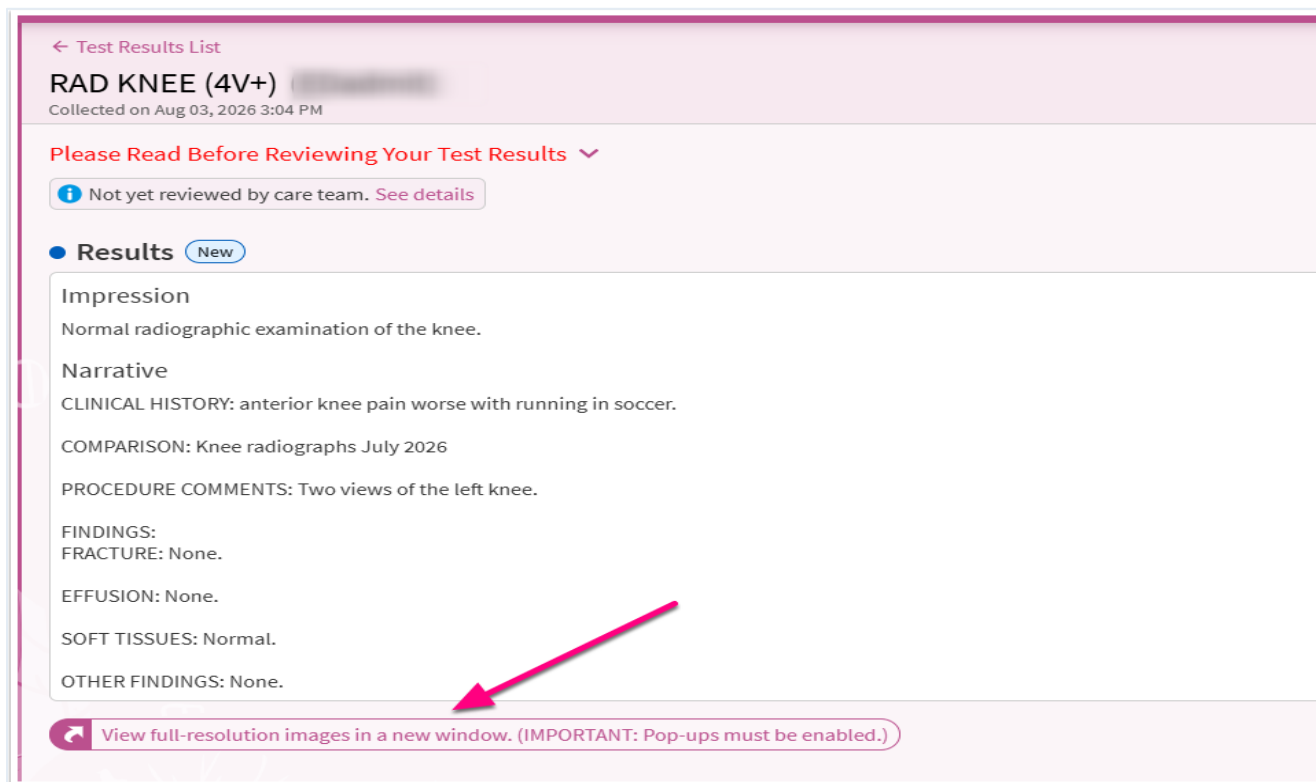


How to View, Share and Download Radiology Images from Mychart

1. Select an Imaging Result from the "Test Results" Activity in MyChart



2. Below the Result, Click the "View full-resolution images in a new window" Link

Cincinnati Children's Imaging History

Access to your entire imaging history is available via Cincinnati Children's MyChart.

By clicking "I Agree" below, you understand that your medical imaging records from Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, including future records (at your discretion), will be transferred via MyChart to a secure account on a platform maintained by PocketHealth, a third party service provider.

Once your records are transferred to your account, you will be able to access, view, download or share them.

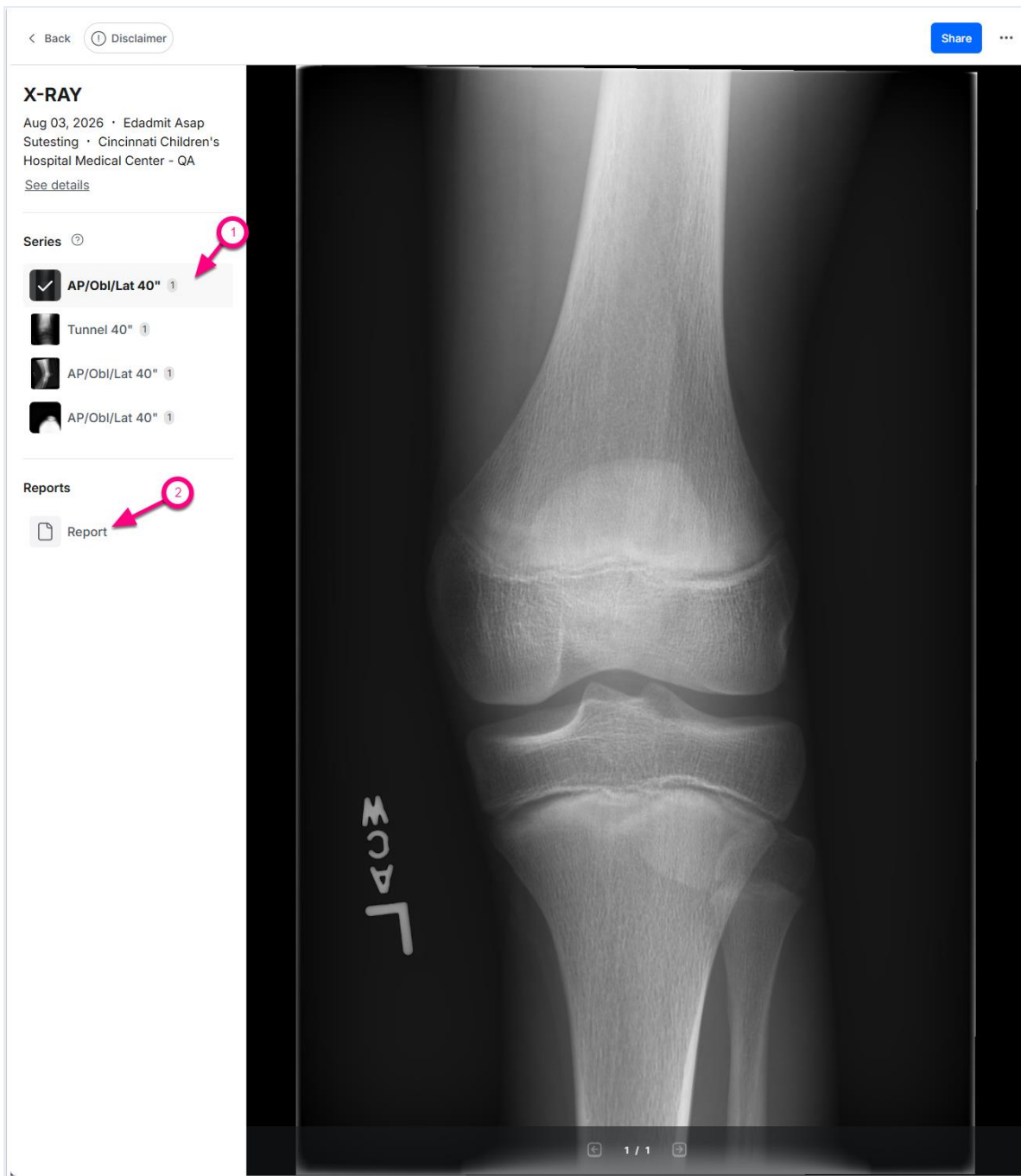

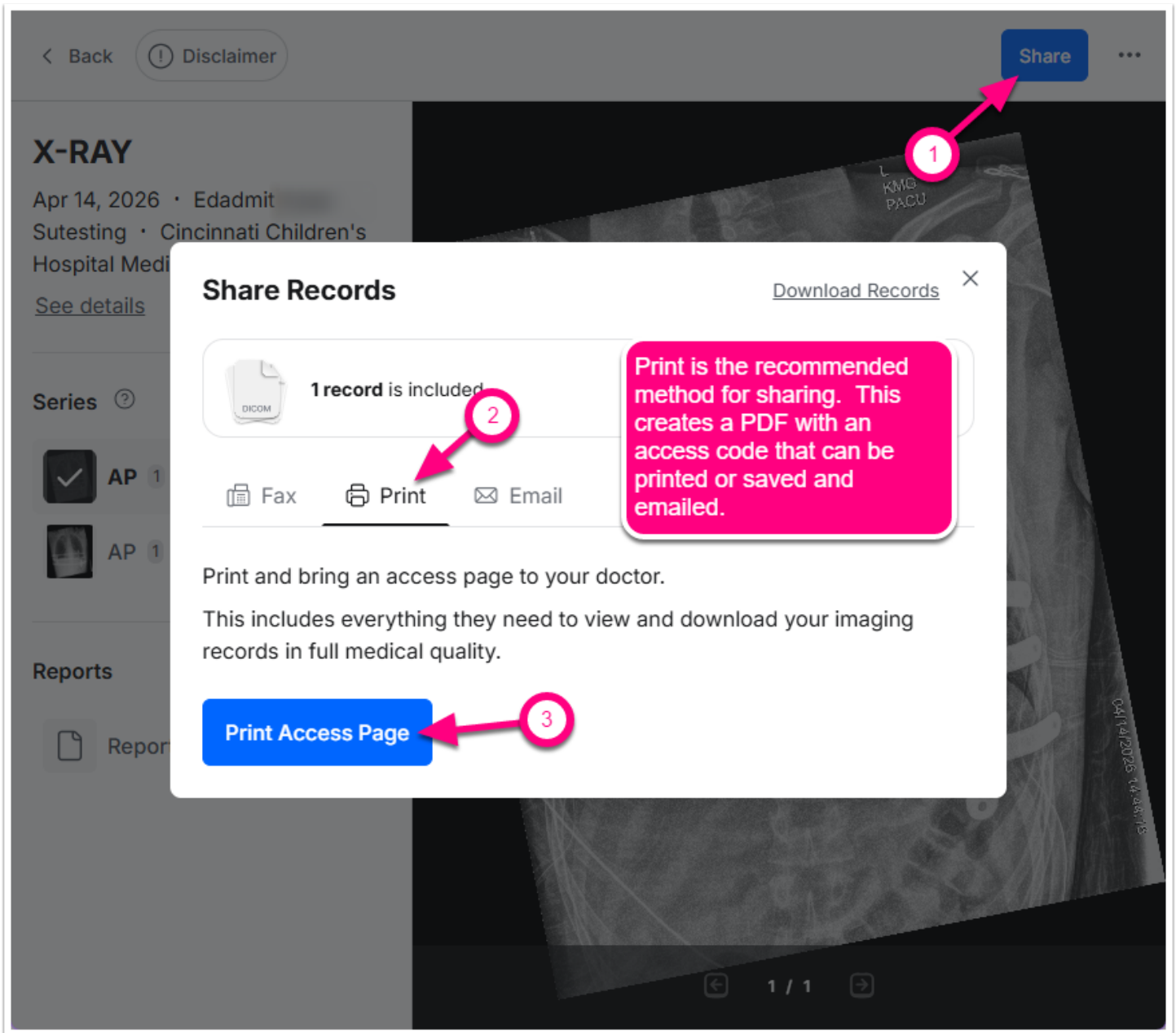

5. Click the Links on the Left View the Images and Report



1. Click each link to view the images or series of the study. For a series with multiple images such as a CT Scan or MRI Scan, use the scroll wheel to scroll through the series.
2. Click "Report" to view a copy of the report (same report visible in the MyChart Test Results section).

6. Click "Share" to Share the Images via Email or Print an Access Page



1. Click the "Share" Button.
2. Click to "Print". This is the recommended sharing method.
3. Click "Print Access Page". This creates a PDF that you can print out to take with you to a visit with your provider. Or you could email the provider/office and attach the document.

7. Click "Download Records" to Download the Images to Your Computer
